Covid-19 Concerns 😊

Many parents worry about their kids possibly contracting Covid-19 while at camp. There are strict guidelines that are in place that we will be follow throughout Camp Breakaway to keep all campers and staff safe.

Guidelines as of March 2021:

- All campers and staff must do one of the following before arriving at camp: 1) be fully vaccinated, OR 2) receive a negative COVID test no more than three days prior to arrival. Rapid testing options are available. Call for questions.
- Camp capacity is determined by sleeping arrangements, as this is the only extended indoor activity. All campers must have at least 6 feet physical distance from other camper's heads in sleep facilities. Bedding shall be arranged head-to-toe. The addition of partitions between beds is not an acceptable substitute.
- Facial coverings are required to be worn at all times by all staff and campers, and anyone else present at the camp, except for when eating, drinking, brushing teeth, or sleeping. Some exceptions are allowed for specific outdoor activities.
- Daily symptom screenings are required for campers and staff.
